Try removing the vowels too.
You can even write it backwards.

5. Removing Vowels

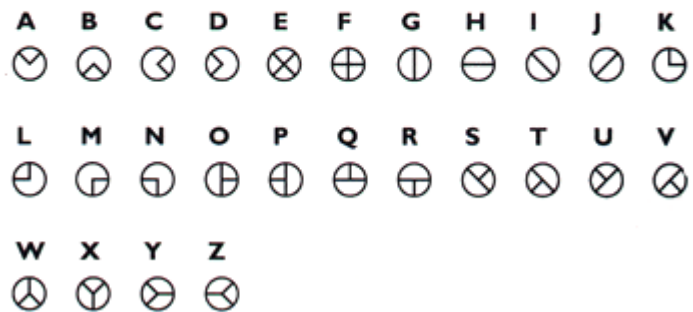
Taking the vowels out of all the words of your message makes a very effective coding system.

Try writing it backwards.

6. Pills

This system looks like different pills.
Try your own designs in the center and create your own code.



7. Morse Code

This code depends on the sender using flags held at various angles to represent letters

Cut-and-paste the images into a message.



8. Backwards Words

This code is simply writing words backwards.

YKCIRT EB NAC SDRAWKCAB GNITIRW
(WRITING BACKWARDS CAN BE TRICKY)

Try removing the vowels and writing it backwards.

9. Moon Writing

This code was developed to be used by the Blind
 A man called William Moon invented it.
 Thus, the name Moon Writing.

A=1, B=2 and so on until Z-26

 (THIS IS GREAT FUN)

A=B, B=C and so on until Z-A
 UFJT JT HSFBU GVO
 (THIS IS GREAT FUN)

11. Grid Code

In this grid, A=A1, B=A2 and so on
 You can change the letters around in the grid to make it more complex!

M to A as 1 to 13 and N to Z as 26 - 14
5/11.13.26/10.25/20.6.5.21/9.13.21.5.2.15
(I CAN DO THIS EASILY)

A to N as even numbers and O to Z as odd numbers
18/6.2.28/8.1/11.16.18.9/10.2.9.18.24.21
(I CAN DO THIS EASILY)

Count by 2's from A to Z
18/6.2.28/8.30/40.16.18.38/10.2.38.18.24.52
(I CAN DO THIS EASILY)
